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# CARIBBEAN STUD POKER RULES

## ANTE BET:

To begin each player must place an ante bet (as in standard poker) prior to the dealer announcing "no more bets." Each player receives five cards face down. The dealer gets four cards face down and one card face up.

## PROGRESSIVE JACKPOT BET:

(In the Cruise Ship version, there is also a progressive bet. But for the Fun Casino, we don't run this part.)

## BET TO CALL DEALER:

If a player feels his hand will beat the dealer's hand and wishes to continue playing, the player must place an additional wager of exactly **twice the ante bet**.

## SURRENDER OR FOLD HAND:

If a player feels he cannot beat the dealer's hand, the player will fold his hand and surrender ante.

## DEALER'S HAND:

Once all the players have made their play or surrender decisions, the Dealer shows all of his cards. The dealer must have an Ace/King high or better to continue to play. If he does not qualify, the player's ante wager is paid even money (1 to 1) and the bet wager is a push, (no action is taken on the bet wager).

If the dealer does have an Ace/King or better and the player's hand is higher in rank than the dealer's hand, the player collects on his ante and bet wagers. If the dealer's hand and the player's hand tie (all five cards are identical in rank), the ante and bet wagers are both pushes and no action is taken.

## CARIBBEAN STUD POKER RULES:

- ◆ Players may not exchange or communicate information regarding their hands. Ant violation will result in a dead hand and forfeiture of all wagers.
- ◆ A Player may play only one hand per round of play.
- ◆ Each player who makes a bet wager shall be responsible for his or her own hand and no other person other than the dealer may touch the cards of that player.

- ◆ Each player shall be required to keep the five cards in full view of the dealer at all times. Once each player has examined his or her own cards and placed them face down on the layout, they may not touch the cards again.
- ◆ If a hole card is exposed prior tot he dealer announcing "no more bets," all hands shall be void.
- ◆ If a player is dealt an incorrect number of cards, that player's hand shall be void. If the dealer is dealt four cards of the five card hand, the dealer shall deal an additional card to complete the hand. Any other misdeal to the dealer shall result in all hands being void and the cards shall be re-shuffled.

## BET WAGER PAYOUT SCHEDULE:

If the dealer's hand is high enough to open and the player's hand is high enough to beat the dealer's hand, the player qualifies for the following payout:

<i>One pair or less</i>	<i>Evens</i>
<i>Two pairs</i>	<i>2:1</i>
<i>Three of a kind</i>	<i>3:1</i>
<i>Straight</i>	<i>4:1</i>
<i>Flush</i>	<i>6:1</i>
<i>Full House</i>	<i>8:1</i>
<i>Four of a kind</i>	<i>20:1</i>
<i>Straight Flush</i>	<i>50:1</i>
